Claire Mix, aka “the Mixer” is a popular elementary school choir teacher in Elk Grove, CA who promotes philanthropy through the joys of singing. One of her four choirs, the Mixer Kids, are acclaimed for giving benefit concerts for charities, performing original pieces composed by Claire. Mixer Kids have performed for children’s hospitals, community and sporting events, the national PTA convention as well as the inaugural celebration of Governor Arnold Schwarzenegger.

Two years ago, Claire Mix was diagnosed with a progressive neurological disorder related to Parkinson disease. She now gets around on the Mixer Mobile, her mobility scooter. She continues to live each day to its fullest, with an up-beat spirit and a positive outlook serving as an inspiration to others. Her students regard her as the same fun teacher who now rides a scooter, often transporting one of them as well.

Beginning July 16, 2005, Claire Mix will embark on an extraordinary journey, traveling by mobility scooter from the Golden Gate Bridge to the California State Capitol in Sacramento to raise funds and awareness. Her message to her students and others is clear: **“Never give up!”**
